## **Excursion to Brussels**

You are very welcome to join our excursion to Brussels to get acquainted with the main institutions of the EU in terms of environmental policy and research: Who are the players, what are the rules, how is the game being played? Where can political decisions be influenced, how and by whom? The excursion is accompanied by a short evening-symposium two weeks before.

## **Excursion on Tuesday 14 October 2014**

Time: 6:00 – 22:00; Transport by bus from Wageningen

Programme includes a visit to the house of Dutch provinces, the Dutch 'Permanente Vertegenwoordiging', and the European Parliament. You will meet a Dutch member of parliament, learn what it's like to work for the Commission, hear about the university's representation in Brussels and Horizon 2020, and discuss Dutch policy with policy-makers.

## Symposium on Thursday 2 October 2014

Time: 18:00 – 20:00; Leeuwenborch Wageningen

During this preparatory symposium we will give you an overview of EU processes, including a general introduction to the EU, decision-making processes in the EU, the influence of the Netherlands in the EU, lobbying and the research programme Horizon 2020. It is also possible to attend the symposium if you will not join the excursion to Brussels.

Entrance is free, but registration is required. At 17:30, we will provide soup and sandwiches for 10€, for which registration is also required.
